**Please note there are major changes in the volunteer schedule for 2020**

**No weekend volunteers (Armory is unavailable until Monday May 18<sup>th</sup> at 8AM.)**

**We need lots of workers Monday 8AM to 8PM (SHIFTS OKAY) Simple lunch and dinner will be provided Monday for all volunteers.**

**Gates for veteran check-in will open Monday afternoon for overnight veteran guests at 3PM**

There are two schools within a block of the fairgrounds, and we are required to run a Megan's Law check on everyone.

Meals, snacks and beverages are provided for all volunteers

**Kitchen:** Opportunities are available for businesses, churches, or organizations to provide a complete meal which includes purchase, preparation, serving, and clean-up.

**Legal:** Attorneys and other legal professionals are needed to help with legal advice and issues.

### **Medical, Dental, Vision,**

**We need Dentists, hygienists and other dental professionals, doctors, nurses, or staff, including a podiatrist or nurse who can clip nails, eye doctors, Opticians, and eye glass lab persons who can make glasses.**

The time frames are Tuesday May 19th and Wed May 20th

Shift one: 7AM to 12:30

Shift two: Noon to 5:00PM or all-day shifts

**Hairdressers and massage therapists, chiropractors, physical therapists are needed Tuesday and Wednesday all day or in shifts**

**Entertainment: Acts who can perform—music, dancing, comedy, magic**

**No weekend shifts this year.**

**Monday (May 18th) 8AM to 8 PM: Come for one shift or two. Need lots of workers to help set up the Stand Down event--- set up tents and cots, cleaning,**

setting up tables and chairs, folding the clothes, unloading boxes, posting signs, and whatever needs to be done to prepare for the event. Need many strong workers able to move and lift boxes and people who can sort and fold clothing. **Sit down jobs are available.** Sign up online as a general volunteer or email [info@placerveteransstanddown.org](mailto:info@placerveteransstanddown.org) to request a group volunteer form for your group to sign up.

**During Stand Down,** Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday: **Volunteers will be scheduled, and each volunteer will need to check in with the Volunteer booth to receive a badge.**

Shifts are Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday

7AM to 12:30 or noon to 5PM

Wednesday 4PM until? Tear-down of Medical/Dental/Vision clinic in Jones Hall

Thursday is clean-up day – come at 7AM—? Breakfast will be served at 7AM.

check in at the security/volunteer booth for assignments for later arrivals

**Jobs available: (We will try to assign you to your first choice, but if jobs are full, we will assign you to what is available in your time frame)**

Security: All shifts, but especially overnight is needed. If we have enough overnight volunteers, we can assign shorter shifts. Coffee and snacks are provided.

Clothing: Sorting and folding new and used clothing and assist vets and families to find sizes.

Desk Jobs/Sit Down jobs are available for those volunteers who have a disability or mobility issue (need registration people for Monday afternoon from 2PM to 8PM, plus all day Tuesday and Wednesday—shifts ok)

**Animal clinic:** Veterinarians, professional staff plus helpers to bathe, clip nails, walk dogs, clean up.

Kid Zone Helpers – supervise and organize activities with the children

Greeters at the front gate, registration staff, and Misc. jobs as needed.
